House Pledge Campaign Begins

Thanks so much for all who prayed about the decisions before our church and participated in our Town Halls and Body Life. At the meeting last Sunday (11/4/18) the church voted to proceed with a funding campaign for purchasing the house at 14240 Spriggs Road and to pay off existing debt. If \$400,000 is pledged by November 28, then financing will be secured and we will seek to purchase the house. Any amount pledged above \$400,000 will be used to pay down the existing debt. My Brother's Keeper Service Project THIS Saturday!

Saturday, November 10, My Brother's Keeper, the Grace Men's Ministry, will return to the Compassion Restoration Firewood Ministry across from Mt. Ararat Church in Stafford. The Compassion Restoration firewood ministry supplies free wood to needy families in the area. It's a great ministry and there is plenty of donated wood. The problem is the wood won't chop itself.

This is the same service project we did last February. Manly activities outdoors were evidently appealing, and we had many requests for a return trip so here it is!

The only portion of the event that's missing is you. To date, we have only a single volunteer.

These are the tasks where manpower is needed:

MANLY MEN: We have room for an unlimited number. These manly volunteers will be beacons to the rest of us as they use axes, mauls, wedges, and sledgehammers to split wood rounds. No experience needed. We will have an instructor. All you need is a strong back and a weak mind.

MECHANICAL MEN: Five volunteers are needed to operate two

gasoline-powered splitters. Two crews of two will operate the splitters and the fifth man will be a floating relief. This job is perfect for men who are too seasoned to swing an ax but are still lively enough to wrestle a wood round under the hydraulic wedge.

MOBILE MEN: These are traveling men who will use wheelbarrows to pick up the split wood and deliver it to be stacked into cords. Each Mobile Man will oversee the operation of his barrow and the Future Men assigned to help. This is a great job for fathers and sons. Four volunteers would be ideal: three to operate wheelbarrows and one to oversee stacking of the split wood.

FUTURE MEN: These are the sons of the Manly, Mechanical and Mobile men. They will be under the supervision of Mobile Men as they help deliver unsplit wood, pickup split wood and stack split wood into cords.
