

Serving Opportunities with Trail Life

Grace sponsors Trail Life Troop VA-2318, which works to guide generations of courageous young men to honor God, lead with integrity, serve others, and experience outdoor adventure. Our troop is in need of both spiritual mentors and Trail Badge mentors. Trail Badge mentors are adults who assist and guide our Trailmen in learning and developing knowledge in a broad range of academic areas and physical activities. Moderate expertise or skill in a subject is usually enough to gather the necessary knowledge for the Trailmen to learn and complete the trail badge requirements.

In addition to badge work, Trail Life has a requirement for spiritual growth. The shape and concept of this growth look different at different ages. For grades K-5, the growth is mainly done as a father/son (or family) devotional. Once the Trailmen enter middle school, the devotional shifts towards a group of father/sons similar to a Sunday morning small group. Once the Trailman enters high school, the goal is to do a one on one devotional with another Godly man. The desired commitment is for at least three months (ideally, 12 one hour meetings) to develop and foster a habit of regularly studying God's word.
